# Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority

The Agricultural and Veterinary Chemical Code Act 1994 (the Act) commenced on 15 March 1995. The Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) scheduled to the Act requires notices to be published in the Gazette containing details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemical products and other approvals granted by the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority. The Agvet Code and related legislation also requires certain other notices to be published in the Gazette. A reference to Agvet Codes in this publication is a reference to the Agvet Code in each state and territory jurisdiction.

The APVMA Gazette is published fortnightly and contains details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemicals products and other approvals granted by the APVMA, notices as required by the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) and related legislation and a range of regulatory material issued by the APVMA.

Pursuant to section 8J(1) of the Agvet Code, the APVMA has decided that it is unnecessary to publish details of applications made for the purpose of notifying minor variations to registration details. The APVMA will however report notifications activity in quarterly statistical reports.

#### Agvet chemical voluntary recall: Bloat-Drench Oral Bloat Control

On 23 December 2025, Victorian Chemical Company Pty Ltd (ACN 004 188 863) initiated a voluntary recall under section 106 of the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code scheduled to the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994 (Cth) in relation to the chemical product described above.

#### Reason for voluntary recall

Due to detection of microbial contamination in the product.

#### Hazard

Due to presence of microbial contaminant, the potency and safety of the product could be compromised. Using a product with compromised potency and safety may:

- result in reduced effectiveness of the treatment
- pose a safety hazard to handlers and to the animals.

#### What to do if in possession of this chemical product

- DO NOT use any containers of the above-mentioned batches.
- Please return the product to the place of purchase for a full refund.
