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Agricultural and veterinary chemicals

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The *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemical Code Act 1994* (the Act) commenced on 15 March 1995. The Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) scheduled to the Act requires notices to be published in the *Gazette* containing details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemical products and other approvals granted by the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority. The Agvet Code and related legislation also requires certain other notices to be published in the *Gazette*. A reference to Agvet Codes in this publication is a reference to the Agvet Code in each state and territory jurisdiction.

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General information

The APVMA Gazette is published fortnightly and contains details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemicals products and other approvals granted by the APVMA, notices as required by the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) and related legislation and a range of regulatory material issued by the APVMA.

Pursuant to section 8J(1) of the Agvet Code, the APVMA has decided that it is unnecessary to publish details of applications made for the purpose of notifying minor variations to registration details. The APVMA will however report notifications activity in quarterly statistical reports.

Notice of proposed amending instrument to the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (Agricultural Active Constituents) Standards 2022

The Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA) is proposing to vary the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (Agricultural Active Constituents) Standards 2022 (the Active Standards) by inserting approved agricultural active constituents.

The APVMA may make standards for chemical products by legislative instrument under section 6E of the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (Agvet Code) scheduled to the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994* (Agvet Code Act).

Under regulation 8AF of the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Regulations 1995 (the Agvet Code Regulations), the APVMA must publish a notice of its intention to vary a standard under section 6E of the Agvet Code, the reasons why the variation is necessary, and how to obtain more information on the variation in the APVMA Gazette and on the APVMA's website. The draft variation must also be published on the website, and a period not less than 28 days permitted for comment on the proposed variation.

Regulation 8AF of the Agvet Code Regulations requires the APVMA to consider whether it is necessary to make the variation, having had regard to relevant international standards, and publish this reason in the Gazette.

Statement as to why the APVMA determines that the variation to the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (Agricultural Active Constituents) Standards 2022 is necessary

The APVMA considers it necessary to vary the standards for currently approved agricultural active constituents to reflect new scientific information and to incorporate new standards for approved active constituents not previously listed. As international standards described in Regulation 8AF(1)(a) are not available for all active constituents proposed in the variation, new and amended standards have been proposed for inclusion in the amending instrument.

The proposed variation includes:

- Making 12 new standards for active constituents used in agricultural chemical products
- Removing 2 existing standards
- Making minor amendments to 38 existing standards

The variation includes standards for malathion and chlorpyrifos to reflect the APVMA's chemical reconsiderations of these 2 active constituents. The [final decision for malathion](#) confirms a minor technical change to the active constituent's name from 'maldison' to 'malathion'. The [final decision for chlorpyrifos](#) confirms the variation of 17 approved active constituents to comply with specific purity requirements. These decisions require amendments to be made to the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (Agricultural Active Constituents) Standards 2022 for both active constituents.

The final decisions of the APVMA's reconsiderations of malathion and chlorpyrifos were published in the APVMA Gazette published on [2 May 2024](#) and [3 October 2024](#), respectively. Increased internal pressure within the container may compromise packaging integrity and could result in leakage, rupture, or bursting during storage, transport, handling, or use which may result in unintended exposure of people or the environment to the product.

Instructions

Instructions for persons who possess, have custody of or use the cancelled active constituent, cancelled product, or the product bearing a cancelled label under section 45B(3) of the Agvet Code.

A person who possesses, has custody of or uses the cancelled active constituent, cancelled product or product bearing a cancelled label referred to in Table 10 in accordance with the instructions contained in this notice, is taken to have been issued with a permit under section 45B(3) of the Agvet Code to possess, have custody of or use the cancelled active constituent, cancelled product or product bearing a cancelled label, in accordance with those instructions.

Possession or custody

A person may possess the cancelled active constituent, cancelled product or product bearing a cancelled label referred to in Table 10 in accordance with its label instructions for 12 months from the date of cancellation.

Use, supply or otherwise deal with

A person may use the cancelled active constituent, cancelled product or products bearing a cancelled label referred to in Table 10 according to its label instructions, including any conditions relating to shelf life or expiry date, for 12 months after the date of cancellation.

A person may supply or cause to be supplied at wholesale or retail level the cancelled active constituent, cancelled product, or product bearing a cancelled label referred to in Table 10, for 12 months after the date of cancellation.

Contraventions

After the day that is 12 months from the date of cancellation it will be an offence against the Agvet Code to have possession or custody of the cancelled active constituents, cancelled products or products bearing a cancelled label with the intention to supply, or to supply the cancelled active constituent, cancelled product, or product bearing a cancelled label.

It is an offence to possess, have custody of, use, or otherwise deal with the cancelled active constituents, cancelled products or products bearing the cancelled label listed in Table 10 in a manner that contravenes the above instructions.
