The *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemical Code Act 1994* (the Act) commenced on 15 March 1995. The Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) scheduled to the Act requires notices to be published in the *Gazette* containing details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemical products and other approvals granted by the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority. The Agvet Code and related legislation also requires certain other notices to be published in the *Gazette*. A reference to Agvet Codes in this publication is a reference to the Agvet Code in each state and territory jurisdiction.

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GENERAL INFORMATION

The *APVMA (Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority) Gazette* is published fortnightly and contains details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemicals products and other approvals granted by the APVMA, notices as required by the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) and related legislation and a range of regulatory material issued by the APVMA.

Pursuant to section 8J(1) of the Agvet Code, the APVMA has decided that it is unnecessary to publish details of applications made for the purpose of notifying minor variations to registration details. The APVMA will however report notifications activity in quarterly statistical reports.

The Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority has before it an application for approval of a new active constituent, clitoria ternatea extract, for use as a novel insecticide for application in cotton.

SUMMARY OF THE APVMA'S EVALUATION OF CLITORIA TERNATEA EXTRACT

ACTIVE CONSTITUENT

The APVMA has evaluated the chemistry aspects of clitoria ternatea extract active constituent (manufacturing process, quality control procedures, batch analysis results and analytical methods) and found them to be acceptable.

On the basis of the data provided, and the toxicological assessment, it is proposed that the following APVMA Active Constituent Standard be established for clitoria ternatea extract active constituent:

Constituent	Specification	Level
Clitoria ternatea extract	total cyclotides	1 g/kg minimum
	total flavonyl glycosides	15 g/kg minimum
	protein	20 g/kg minimum

Other solids and compounds of toxicological significance are not expected to occur in clitoria ternatea extract TGAC as a result of the raw materials and the extraction method used.

The Office of Chemical Safety has considered the toxicological aspects of clitoria ternatea extract TGAC, and advised that there are no toxicological objections to the approval of this chemical.

An ADI of 10 mg/kg bw/d is established, based on a NOEL of 1000 mg/kg bw/d for no effects observed in a 90-day oral toxicity study in rats and applying a 100-fold safety factor. An ARfD has not been established at this time for clitoria ternatea extract, and no data have been provided to enable an ARfD to be set.

The Advisory Committee on Chemicals Scheduling (ACCS) has considered clitoria ternatea extract to be appropriate for inclusion in Appendix B of the Standard for the Uniform Scheduling of Medicines and Poisons (SUSMP) at its July 2015 meeting. The Delegate's final decision is expected to be published on 19 November 2015.

The APVMA accepts the findings and recommendations of its advisers on these criteria.

The APVMA is satisfied that the proposed importation and use of clitoria ternatea extract would not be an undue toxicological hazard to the safety of people exposed to it during its handling and use.

MAKING A SUBMISSION

In accordance with sections 12 of the Agvet Code, the APVMA invites any person to submit a relevant written submission as to whether the application for approval of clitoria ternatea extract should be granted. Submissions should relate only to matters that the APVMA is required by legislation to consider in deciding whether to grant the approval. These grounds include chemistry and manufacture, and toxicity. Submissions should state the grounds on which they are based. Comments received outside these grounds cannot be considered by the APVMA.

Submissions must be received by the APVMA within 28 days of the date of this notice and be directed to the contact listed below. All submissions to the APVMA will be acknowledged in writing via email or by post. A summary of relevant comments and the APVMA's response will be published on the APVMA website.
