The *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994* (the Act) commenced on 15 March 1995. The Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) scheduled to the Act requires notices to be published in the Gazette containing details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemical products and other approvals granted by the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority. The Agvet Code and related legislation also requires certain other notices to be published in the *Gazette*.

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**GENERAL INFORMATION**

The *APVMA (Australian Pesticides & Veterinary Medicines Authority) Gazette* is published monthly and contains details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemical products and other approvals granted by the APVMA, notices as required by the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) and related legislation, and a range of regulatory material issued by the APVMA.

Pursuant to section 53(1) of the Agvet Code, the APVMA has decided that it is unnecessary to publish details of applications made for the purpose of notifying minor variations to registration details. The APVMA will however report notifications activity in quarterly statistical reports.

*AMENDMENT No. 9L***Amendments to the MRL Standard**

The Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA) sets maximum residue limits (MRLs) of agricultural and veterinary chemicals in agricultural produce, particularly produce entering the food chain. These MRLs are set at levels which are not likely to be exceeded if the agricultural or veterinary chemicals are used in accordance with approved label instructions. At the same time the APVMA is satisfied, from dietary exposure assessment, that the levels are not an undue hazard to human health.

The MRL Standard lists MRLs of substances which may arise from the approved use of those substances or other substances, and provides the relevant residue definitions to which these MRLs apply.

The evaluation process takes into account studies on chemistry, metabolism, analytical methodology, residues, good agricultural practice, toxicology and dietary exposure. From time to time the evaluation process results in amendments to the MRL Standard. It should be noted that relevant MRLs are referred to Food Standards Australia New Zealand for incorporation into Standard 1.4.2 of the Food Standards Code entitled "Maximum Residue Limits".

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**Note:** ‘\*’ denotes that the maximum residue limit (MRL) has been set at or about the limit of analytical quantitation (see: Residue Guideline No.4, *Maximum Residue Limit Proposals ‘At or about the Limit of Analytical Quantitation’*, published in NRA Gazette No.9, p44, 5/9/95).

‘T’ denotes that the MRL, residue definition or use is temporary to enable further experimental work to be carried out in Australia or overseas, and will be reconsidered at some future date.

## NOTICE

### **Cancellation of nominated Queensland Board Approvals**

Prior to the commencement of the National Registration Scheme the Queensland Department of Primary Industries and Fisheries issued approvals for off-label use of pesticides (known as Queensland Board Approvals) across a range of horticultural and agricultural commodities and veterinary situations, commonly without expiry dates. As of the 15<sup>th</sup> March 1995 these approvals became APVMA permits under transitional arrangements within the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act.

The APVMA is reassessing these permits to verify whether the permitted uses meet contemporary standards of safety and performance, taking into account any new information and scientific data generated since these uses were first permitted. This reassessment has identified 265 Queensland Board Approvals (including 521 different use patterns) that have been cancelled under s19(3) of the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code*. Appropriate consultation and communication with relevant industry associations has also been undertaken on the cancellations included in this notice. Table 1 below lists the cancelled Queensland Board Approvals. These approvals were cancelled for various reasons including situations where, (i) the use is inconsistent with a regulatory outcome following an APVMA chemical review, (ii) industry no longer require the approved use pattern, (iii) the approved product is no longer registered or (iv) the approved use pattern has been registered and included on a currently approved product label.

Where these cancelled use patterns involve chemicals that do not have any active constituent approvals or registered products, if application for new products or permits were received in the future, the applicant would be required to provide a complete data package to support both active ingredient approval as well as product registration.

The APVMA will continue its re-assessment of the remaining Queensland Board Approvals of which approximately another 500 remain. For further information in regard to the cancellation of these approvals or the re-assessment of Queensland Board Approvals please contact;
